General Overview: Do not use acronyms

Handle With Care is a behavior management system dedicated to reducing institutional violence through tension-reduction interventions and techniques—both verbal and physical. It trains staff to use these preventative strategies to minimize the need for physical restraint.

How will this impact student learning in a positive way?

This annual training, which includes both verbal and physical interventions, will positively impact daily interactions with students who struggle with self-regulation. The techniques learned will help keep both students and staff safe during situations that have the potential to cause harm. The goal of the behavior management system is to preserve students' dignity and ensure their safety when they are exhibiting harmful behaviors.

*How will I implement what I learned and how will I share
this information with my colleagues?*

Annual training is required for all staff who work with students in our special programs. This training will be conducted in person to ensure the program's integrity is upheld and that all verbal and physical skills are properly practiced. Staff must demonstrate all required skills to be recertified each school year.
