



Date of Board Meeting: May 17, 2022 Subject: Student Fees Approve student fee increase for Dental Hygiene course, DHYG 1304, effective fall 2022 Recommendation: **Background and Rationale:** Students are required to purchase a dental instrument to facilitate radiograph exposure on clinical patients. The use of a holding device (type of dental instrument) is mandatory per state regulations and Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA). Presently, students purchase the device at a retail cost of \$250 as part of a program instrument kit. However, if purchased through the college, the cost drops to \$110. Adding \$110 course fee to DHYG 1304 Dental Radiology is a cost savings for students. The current fee for DHYG 1304 Dental Radiology is \$25 for lab materials. The additional fee brings the total course fee to \$135, yet saves each student \$140 (\$250-\$110). Cost and Budgetary Support: No cost. Estimated revenue from fees is \$3080 to offset the instrument cost.
