BOARD POLICY PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL APPOINTMENT GBD JUNE 20, 1988

The comptroller and all certificated employees of the school district All members of Cabinet, LEADS, and LEA shall be appointed only upon the recommendation of the superintendent and approval by the Board of Education. Should a nominee of the superintendent be rejected by the Board, it shall be the duty of the superintendent to make another nomination.

It shall be the duty of the superintendent or designee to see that persons recommended for employment shall meet all qualifications established by law, by contractual agreement, and by the Board for that type of position.

It shall be the duty of the superintendent or designee to hire all employees for positions which do not require certification.

BOARD POLICY INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES IDF JUNE 20, 1988

The Livonia Board of Education recognizes the need for and encourages student participation in extracurricular and interscholastic activities.

The Board further recognizes that participating in these activities carries with it the responsibility of good behavior in and out of the school. Failure on the part of any student to meet this responsibility is cause for suspension or removal from participation.
