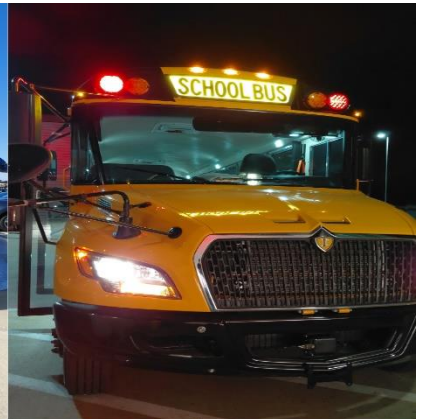

Due to weather we had to work to reschedule **21** trips.

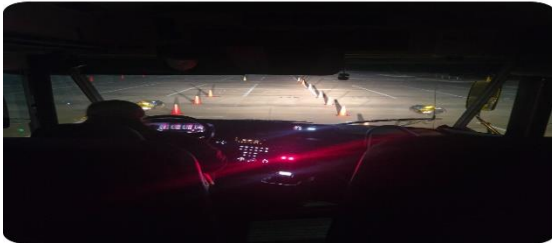
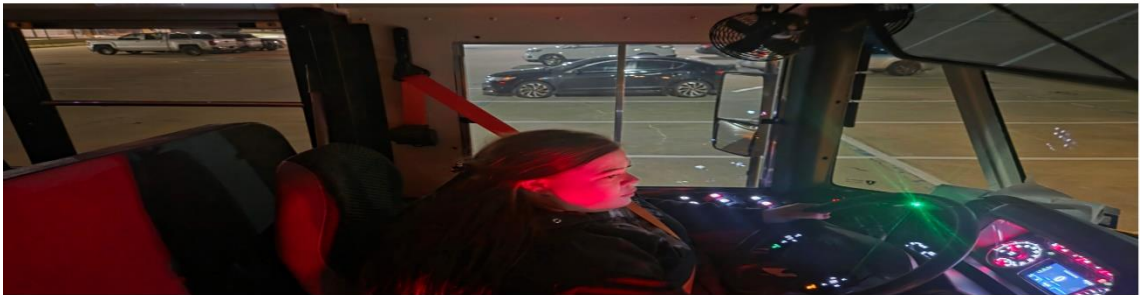
New Buses Have Arrived

We received one full size 77 passenger bus and one Special Education bus that can hold up to 53 passengers. The new buses are equipped with LED stop arms and bus signage to increase visibility in low-light conditions to enhance student safety.
