Vaping has become a significant issue in schools across the country. Just like the trends throughout the nation, Bridgman High School (BHS) has seen an increase in vaping incidents. Some of the high schools across Southwest Michigan have incorporated the use of hand held metal detectors to find vapes as they are sometimes impossible to find with just a visual search. BHS is looking to use the same strategy to deter students from bringing vapes to school. A letter and protocols have been written for the use of the handheld device. This letter has been sent to the school attorney to review. After the review is complete, the letter will be sent home to parents and the policy will be explained to the students before moving forward with the use of the device.
