### United Independent School District Compliance Plan Fall 2008

United Independent School District continues to experience student enrollment growth; therefore, the district persists in its recruiting efforts, construction of additional campuses, and the constant evaluation of boundaries and student demographics.

### Gutierrez Elementary (240-903-114) TEA Recognized Rating:

### 2 sections in 4<sup>th</sup> grade over the 22:1 ratio

The district has taken the following measures to assure that this campus is in compliance with class size requirements:

- the district will continue to work closely with the district's demographer to review district wide growth to plan accordingly;
- this campus has a unique situation due to the reason that this campus is one of two *Gifted and Talented Magnet Schools*. Those Gifted and Talented students in grades 3-5 who choose to attend this campus are homogenously grouped. The two sections that are over the 22:1 ratio are composed of G.T. students.

### Killam Elementary (240-903-132)--No rating because it is a new campus:

### 4 sections in 1st grade over the 22:1 ratio

The district has taken the following measures to assure that this campus is in compliance with class size requirements:

- the district will continue to work closely with the district's demographer to review district wide growth to plan accordingly;
- the district will relocate portable buildings to campuses with over-projected enrollments;

### Other steps that the district has taken include:

- Continue collaborative efforts with local educational institutions to graduate qualified paraprofessional staff members as teachers.
- The district has established a "Tomorrow's Teachers" Project. This project addresses the need for qualified teachers in all areas of education and plans to meet the challenge by "growing our own" teachers from the talented pool of United I.S.D. students.
- The District is currently meeting with a citizen's group consisting of over 100 constituents to review the district's growth and how to best deal with it. The committee is looking at the possibility of a new bond election.

### **Public Notice**

The United Independent School District will apply for a class-size waivers for Gutierrez Elementary due to scheduling conflicts produced by the Gifted and Talented Magnet Program and Killam Elementary because of high student growth. State law mandates a 22.1 student-teacher ratio in grades K-4, and a waiver is required by law should a class exceed that amount. The District will continue to work with the demographers for projections and relocate portable classrooms and/or adjust boundaries where needed.
