TOPIC: Approval to Purchase *Everyday Mathematics* Student Journals

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of *Everyday Mathematics* student journals for first through fifth grade classes and sixth grade at Webster, from McGraw Hill Education for a total cost of \$266,763.10, which includes shipping and handling. This purchase is for the three school years 2019-2022 and includes \$125,178.30 in free student journals over the three years.

RATIONALE:

This purchase of consumable *Everyday Mathematics* Student Journals will be for the three school years 2019-2022 and will be used to support mathematics instruction based on the *Everyday Mathematics* Program. The recommendation has been reviewed and supported by the Board Curriculum Committee.

The Everyday Mathematics student journals will be charged to the District's elementary textbook account.
