Background Information

Beginning on September 21st, a summary of the Implementation of Education Plan will be included as an attachment. Other updates include:

Employees	<p>The district still needs teacher substitutes at \$200/day and special education assistants.</p> <p>Due to room capacity limits, the district is closely monitoring the possible need for adding a Kindergarten teacher.</p> <p>There are enough 5th and 6th graders participating in online-only, so the administrative team is reviewing options for assigning teachers to teach remotely.</p> <p>An additional online only teacher is being hired for 1st grade due to high enrollment numbers. This is in addition to having 2 online-only teachers for 2nd grade, 2 for 3rd grade, and 2 for 4th grade (1 of the 2 being hired).</p>
In-Person Board Meetings	<p>We believe the best location for in-person board meetings will be the Twin Bluff auditorium due to scheduling conflicts with Hovda Hall. Dawn Wettern is working on a COVID plan and Karsten Anderson will work on technology options.</p>
Fall Sports	<p>A vote is being taken at the Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) on Friday, September 18th about moving football and volleyball seasons back to this fall.</p>

MSHSL COVID Charges	Due to revenue shortfalls as a result of COVID, MSHSL will be charging member districts additional membership fees. August's invoice for Red Wing was \$5158 with two installment COVID charges of \$4500 due in November and \$4500 due in February.
Educational Data Sharing Agreements and Student Releases	Various data practices are being reviewed, including educational data sharing agreements with non-school entities such as Every Hand Joined, Youth Outreach, and Hispanic Outreach.
E-Learning Plan	Karsten Anderson will be sharing a draft copy of an E-Learning Plan with local unions and school board so that snow days are limited.
Free and Reduced Lunch Applications	We need families to complete Free and Reduced Lunch Applications even if they are already taking free meals.
