It is recommended that the Board approve the selection of commissioning services for the Selma ES project in Bond 2022 and that the Board of Trustees delegate the authority to the Superintendent or their designee to execute all contracts and related documents necessary to complete this project. The scope of work includes commissioning services to verify all MEP (Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing) systems in Selma ES are installed and operate per the contract documents and project requirements. Expenditures will be made from Bond 2022 funds at a total estimated cost of \$98,750.00.
