Bylaws of the Board

Number of Members, Terms of Office, Oath of Office

The Board of Education consists of (9) members who are elected for two (2) years.

Terms of Office

The term of office of a school Board member shall be for two years. Members shall take office at the first Monday in December. Before entering upon their official duties, members of the Board of Education shall take the oath of office before the Town Clerk or other authorized individual. Election of officers shall take place at a special Board meeting held immediately after the Board has taken the oath of office.

Term of Board Officers

All officers of the Board shall hold office for a term of two years and until their successors are elected and have qualified, except in case of removal as provided in Bylaw 9222.
