Revision of EIE (Local) Academic Achievement: Retention & Promotion

Purpose of Report

Section 101.2019 (b) states "The school board of each district and each charter school may establish a policy that provides for the placement of retained students in an age-appropriate learning environment in accordance with local grade configurations for elementary, middle, and high school campuses, this policy may specify the age by which a retained student should be placed on the next level campus even though not yet promoted to the grade of that campus."

This gives the Board the option to establish a policy that provides for the placement of a retained student in an age-appropriate learning environment.
