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2024-25 Federal Programs Preliminary Allocations

Every year, the Idaho Department of Education receives allocations from the U.S. Department of Education and makes several adjustments to project accurate allocations. This adjustment process has been delayed this year and is still underway. They project we won't have those numbers until the end of May. In order to proceed with opening the CFSGA they have uploaded allocations based off a 3% reduction from prior year allocations as seen below.
