Teachers and administrators took part in a Sheltered Instruction Observation Protocol (SIOP) training which gave staff the opportunity to learn the SIOP framework on August 6-8, 2018. Teachers and administrators learned how to develop students' academic language skills and content knowledge at the same time. Our certified SIOP trainer led engaging, interactive, hands-on professional learning opportunities that gave our staff different techniques to incorporate in their lesson planning, scaffolding and learning strategies as well as during their lesson delivery. Teachers and administrators learned about the 8 components of the SIOP model and how to incorporate this framework in their classroom. All staff who participated in the 3 day program received a certificate for their participation in the training. Teachers from out of district paid a fee of \$650 to attend and help offset cost of the training. There will be second training for teachers and staff members who were not able to participate in August. The dates for the training will be October 1 - 3, 2018.
