## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a significant portion of the United Independent School District's ("District") ad valorem taxes are delinquent to the District's detriment; and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas pursuant to the Texas Property Tax Code, provides school districts with the authority to impose a collection fee and/or charge on delinquent ad valorem taxes when it has entered into a tax collection contract with an attorney; and

WHEREAS, the District has engaged a private law firm to collect its delinquent ad valorem taxes, and

WHEREAS, the District now wishes to adjust the collection fee and/or charge on delinquent taxes according to the current contract with that firm.

## NOW IT IS THEREFORE, HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE UNITED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

- 1. That the District does hereby exercise its statutory right to impose an additional collection fee and/or charge on all delinquent taxes, penalties and interest due, pursuant to the terms of the Property Tax Code and the current contract with law firm, so long as the District retains a delinquent tax firm, and
- 2. That the District's Tax Collector is hereby directed to send out all required notices to delinquent taxpayers of the herein imposed additional collection fee and/or charge on delinquent taxes, penalty and interest, as required by the Tax Code.
