Description: On May 31, 2023 the Texas Education Agency (TEA) released the adopted

> Texas Administrative Code Rules Concerning School Facilities. One of the new requirements states that at minimum all windows, except when inside an exterior secured area, all ground-level windows near exterior doors and that are of a size and position that permits entry from the exterior if broken shall be constructed or modified such that the glass cannot be easily broken and allow an intruder to

enter through the window frame.

On October 18, 2023, the Board of Trustees approved RFP 2023-14 Safety and Security Window Film Installation, but the window safety glazing alternate was not presented due to the lack of funding. The district has since been awarded an allotment for the SAFE (Safety and Facilities Enhancement Grant) in the amount of \$5,627,213. In an effort to increase the effectiveness of the window film, district staff would like to accept the alternate glazing installation. The window glazing treatment is an additional \$293,252. Please find enclosed the pricing submitted by the vendors to achieve this district wide.
