Background Information:

- AP (Advanced Placement) examinations are administered each year in May and represent the culmination of college level work.
- Thirty-seven different subject area AP courses are offered nationwide. Keller ISD offered 31 courses and students tested in thirty-four of the thirty-seven AP exams.
- Exams are scored on a scale of 1-5 with scores of 3, 4, and 5 receiving college credit from participating universities.
