This Board Report is requesting approval of the Integrated Grant Application for Three Rivers School District, including Woodland Charter School and Kalmiopsis Community Arts High School. The Integrated Grant Application includes narrative essays and budgets for 2025-2026 and 2026-2027 for both TRSD and each charter school. As required by the Oregon Department of Education, this application is brought to the board for approval as an action item along with the opportunity for public feedback during the "Public Comment" section of the meeting. The entire application will be posted to the public school district website upon approval by the school board.

Provide history/background information on your proposal:

The Integrated Grant from the Oregon Department of Education combines multiple grants into one singular application and reporting system. The grants include: Student Investment Account, High School Success, Early Literacy Grant, and Early Indicator and Intervention Systems. The grant application is for the upcoming biennium (2025-2027). TRSD and the charter schools engaged in extensive community engagement to hear from all stakeholders what is working well in the district, what we can do to help their child succeed, and prioritized list of activities and classes they want to continue or add. We were intentional to have open conversations with parents/guardians and focal student groups representing subpopulations that have historically been underrepresented. These conversations were powerful and we are thankful to those who participated for their honest feedback. The budget reflects current staffing and there is a tab that outlines our tiered planning if additional funds become available.

List the advantages of your proposal:

The Integrated Grant requires the board to review the application and provide for public comment on the various components. Once approved by the board, the documents and information will be submitted to ODE by April 30, 2025. Staff and activities already funded by these grants are included in the next biennium and we hope to continue it with approval by the board.

If the grant application is not approved or submitted, significant funds will not be available to TRSD and the two charter schools.
