Please state your proposal briefly and clearly. What do you want the board to know, discuss, or decide?

The District has completed the competitive bidding process for the North Valley High School (NVHS) Press Box and Bleachers construction project. The winning bid to award Vitus Construction, Inc., per the attached Bid Summary Report, total is \$1,015,944.16. The District recommends completing the project in two (2) phases to accommodate project feasibility for funding requirements and promoting student safety. It is recommended the board approve the bid award amount of \$1,015,944.16 with the Phase I contract amount of \$599,385.00 to begin Spring 2026. Phase II to be completed contingent on the availability of funding, with approval per District Policies DJ and DJC.

Provide history/background information on your proposal:

The District has collaborated with the NVHS Booster Club to organize the completion of this project. The NVHS Booster Club has previously fund raised and purchased the bleachers for this project and has raised additional funding for completing Phase I. The District will allocate \$350,000.00 of capital budget funding to the project, primarily sourced from the sale of the Selma property.

List the advantages of your proposal:

Approving the contract now will allow sufficient time to complete Phase I during the summer break to be available for use in the next school year. Breaking the project into two (2) phases accommodates the funding needs of the district, allows the North Valley High School Booster Club opportunities for additional fund raising, and implements immediate safety improvements for the facilities.

List possible disadvantages of your proposal:

Dividing the project into two (2) phases delays full completion of the project.

List possible alternatives that could also offer a solution to your proposal. Why were they not recommended?
