REVIEW OF PRESS MEMO 103

DEVELOPMENT OF BOARD POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS

The following was discussed:

- 2:150-AP –Change Employee Drug Abuse Committee to Employee Substance Abuse Committee through the Administrative Procedure and add clarification to Concussion Oversight Team regarding the coach not being the coach of the team who approves the Return to Play of a student athlete
- Policy 5:60, *Expenses* – Remove verbiage regarding advancements from this policy and share with staff annually
- Policy 5:280, *Duties and Obligations* – The verbiage regarding Non-certificated and Unlicensed Personnel #1 is confusing

The Title IX Newsletter was discussed.

BOARD REQUESTED POLICY REVIEW OF 5:120, 5:125, AND 6:235

The following was discussed:

- 5:125, *Personal Technology and Social Media Usage* – Dr. Hubbard would like to be more upfront about these policies with staff at the beginning of each school year
- Guidelines for Acceptable Use of Technology for Employees – Add language about not using personal devices inappropriately and do not use a personal device for work business. Also, look into how often the agreement is signed by staff. This topic will be a Teacher Institute Day topic.
- Guidelines for Responsible Use of Technology for Students – Include this in a Teacher Institute Day topic

BOARD REQUESTED REVIEW OF POSSIBLE NEW POLICY ON NEPOTISM

Two sample policies from neighboring districts were reviewed for a new Antioch School District 34 policy 5:32.
