Agenda Item Title: 2025-2026 South San Antonio ISD Pay and Compensation Plan Amendments

Description: The 2025–2026 Pay and Compensation Plan includes all pay scales, pay ranges, and stipends for each position within the District. The proposed amendments to the 2025–2026 plan are designed to support the District’s vision, goals, and operational needs by strengthening efforts to recruit and retain highly qualified staff. These adjustments align compensation structures with organizational priorities and promote positive student outcomes.

Historical Data: The SSAISD Board of Managers approved the 2025–2026 Pay and Compensation Plan on August 4, 2025. Additionally, on February 23, 2026 the Board approved amendments made to the 2025-2026 Pay and Compensation Plan.

The TRA increase will be considered the alternative salary. The alternative salaries are based on 10 month employment for the 25-26 school year. Salary plans are determined on an annual basis and salary advancements are not guaranteed.
