This letter is to inform those concerned of my resignation from School District Number Nine as a 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, grade Physical Education Teacher effective the last day of the 2018-2019 school year.

I would like to be considered for future coaching positions. In 1984 I applied for a head coaching position at Browning High School. At that time the school board was only hiring those people with a college degree, so I attended Montana State University starting in 1986 and graduated in 1990 with a degree in Broadfield K-12 Physical Education. My first teaching job was in Lame Deer Montana at the junior high there in 1990. The following year I was hired at Napi Elementary, which then was Douglas Gold and the year was fall 1991.

Teaching at the Napi Elementary for the past 28 years has been a wonderful and fulfilling endeavor. The staff have been outstanding and the leadership superior for the time of my career at Napi Elementary. I will always hold Browning Public Schools dear to my heart and especially Napi Elementary, for it was there that I started in 1991 and continued since 2019, making for a total of 28 years.

I was unfortunate to have suffered a serious quadriceps injury December 18<sup>th</sup>, and had surgery Decmeber 26<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and had to be away from work up until April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2019.

Having the injury has put a new outlook on life for me, hence my decision to retire.
