Purpose of Report

The Denton Central Appraisal District (DCAD) has requested its taxing jurisdictions to <u>nominate up to five people</u> to be considered for their Board of Directors. According to Section 6.03 of the Property Tax Code, it is the chief appraiser's responsibility to initiate this process. The chief appraiser does not have the authority, or duty to investigate, or judge, the qualifications of the nominees. The nominations must be returned to the Denton Appraisal District by October 15, 2021.

Objectives

To provide the District with a possible appointment on the Denton Central Appraisal District Board of Directors. Currently, Charles Stafford is the District's representative and his term expires in December 2021.

An individual that is serving on the governing body of a city, county, or school district is eligible to serve as an appraisal district's director. There is a total of 5000 votes combined for all of the jurisdictions which will equal 833 votes for a candidate to be confirmed. Those elected to the Board of Directors will serve a two-year term beginning January 1, 2022.
