A Board shall establish a local School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) to assist a District in ensuring that local community values are reflected in the District's health education instruction. A majority of the Council must be parents of students enrolled in the District and who are not employed by the District. The Board may also appoint one (1) or more school teachers, public school administrators, district students, healthcare professionals, members of the business community, law enforcement representatives, senior citizens, clergy, representatives of non-profit health organizations, or representatives from other groups.

There are currently two (2) vacant Parent Member SHAC positions, and no (0) Community Member positions. The District has received an adequate number of Parent applications to fill the 2017-18 SHAC Membership vacancies. No further recruiting or advertising is necessary. District Principals have been contacted for possible Parent Member Applicants to provide for ballot opportunities.

The Board of Trustees shall consider, but is not limited to, written applications that are submitted by any eligible person desiring to serve on the Council.

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees take action and appoint/reappoint applicants to serve as a School Health Advisory Council member for a two (2) year term.
