



SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

NOVEMBER 2020

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:

- 2020 Budgeted Enrollment at 2139.
- Current Enrollment at 2193 with 3.8% Online.
- Health Alerts Website-Updated. Current Data: 16 cases. 12 recovered. 4 active.
- This Week: Volleyball on Tuesday in Cuero; Football on Friday in Belton.
- Some districts in our area and region have had to return to fully online learning platforms in response to spikes in cases of COVID-19 (Burton, Brazos);
- We are continuing to have student, staff, and parent three week feedback sessions;
- We will be meeting this week with faculty to determine a recommended direction for online learning in the spring 2021 semester. Recommendations and options currently being considered include:
 - Students who have three or more unexcused absences and/or failed a class as an online learning during the first semester will not be eligible to remain online unless they have medical certification recommending such;
 - Students participating in onsite extracurricular events must be enrolled onsite.
 - To Be Determined:
 - Consider online learning PK-12 or shift to 6-12 with all elementary students returning onsite;
 - Consider whether online instruction is best delivered by our teachers (as is currently taking place) or best delivered through a fully online curriculum platform such as Edgenuity
