- Updates on projects currently in development from January meeting:
 - An annual sponsorship brochure – this is completed and samples will be distributed
 - Limited edition Bicentennial t-shirts to benefit the Endowment – currently for sale internally, working on a few other options

- Updates on Author Events:
 - January 30th: Melanie Benjamin, new book: *The Swans of Fifth Avenue* – we had a crowd of 150 and sold 80 of her books
