I. STUDENT DISCIPLINARY HEARING

- A. Call to Order: President Knowles called the meeting to order at 7:38 p.m.
- B. Audience: No one wished to address the Board on a non-agenda item.
- C. Closed Session: Approval to go into Closed Session at the request of the students and parents, which is in accordance with Public Act #267, Section 8(a) of the Open Meetings Act of 1976, as amended - ROLL CALL VOTE: A motion was made by Forsyth and supported by Eldred to go into closed session.

II. RETURN TO OPEN SESSION:

- A. Approval to accept the Administration's recommendation for expulsion of Student 2009H based on violation of the Code of Conduct resulting from breaking and entering, damaging property, and setting a fire at Indian Lake Elementary on March 28, 2010. Student 2009H will be eligible to apply for readmission after the balance of the 2010-2011 school year. A motion was made by Emmert and supported by Eldred to accept the Administration's recommendation.
Motion carried unanimously.
- B. Approval to accept the Administration's recommendation for expulsion of Student 2009I based on violation of the Code of Conduct resulting from breaking and entering and damaging property at Indian Lake Elementary on March 28, 2010. Student 2009I will be eligible to reapply for admission for the second semester of the 2010-2011 school year. A motion was made by Forsyth and supported by Emmert to accept the Administration's recommendation.
Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Knowles informed the parent and students that expulsion means that the students are

now allowed on school property at any time without permission from the Administration. The parent was informed that Mr. Kuhlman and Mr. O'Neill would assist with alternative educational placement.

There being no further business to come before the Board, President Knowles adjourned the meeting at 8:02 pm.
