Pursuant to authority vested in the Bureau of Mediation Services, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED THAT THE MINNESOTA SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, ST. PAUL, MINNESOTA,

has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above-named employer who voted in the unit described below, as their exclusive representative for the purposes of collective bargaining, and that, pursuant to the Public Employment Labor Relations Act of 1971 as amended, the said organization is the exclusive representative of all the employees in such unit for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, wages, hours of employment, and other conditions of employment.

UNIT: All cafeteria, custodial/maintenance, secretary/clerkical, transportation and teacher aide employees employed by Independent School District No. 363, Northome, Minnesota, whose employment service exceeds the lesser of 14 hours per week or 35 percent of the normal work week and more than 100 work days per year, excluding supervisory and confidential employees.

The Cease and Desist Order issued on March 5, 1980, is hereby lifted in its entirety.
