Subject: Create a New Career and Transfer Advising Center on Richmond Campus with Title V HSI Grant

Funds

Recommendation: Approve Renovation to Create a Career and Transfer Advising Center

Background and Rationale: The Board of Trustees approved seeking the Title V HSI Grant in September 2020 for the purpose of increasing the completion, persistence, and transfer rates of students, particularly Hispanic and First-Time-in-College students, through the creation of a career and transfer center. A Career and Transfer Center was created on the Wharton campus, and now the College would like to allocate an unused student service space on the Richmond campus to create a Career and Transfer Center on that campus. The renovation plans would create a single space where students can receive academic, career, transfer, and financial advising. The cost of the renovation is \$70,000, funded by the Title V grant. The cost of office furniture (\$4500) is not an allowable expense of the grant thus will be funded using the FY23 budget.
