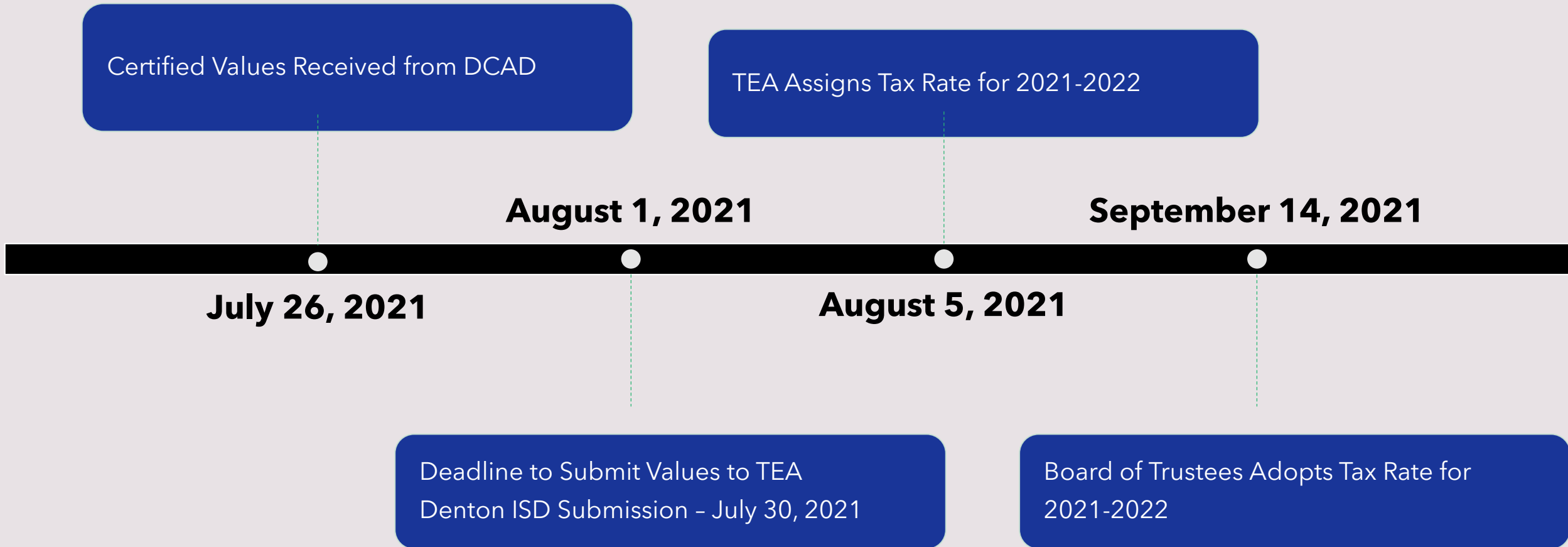

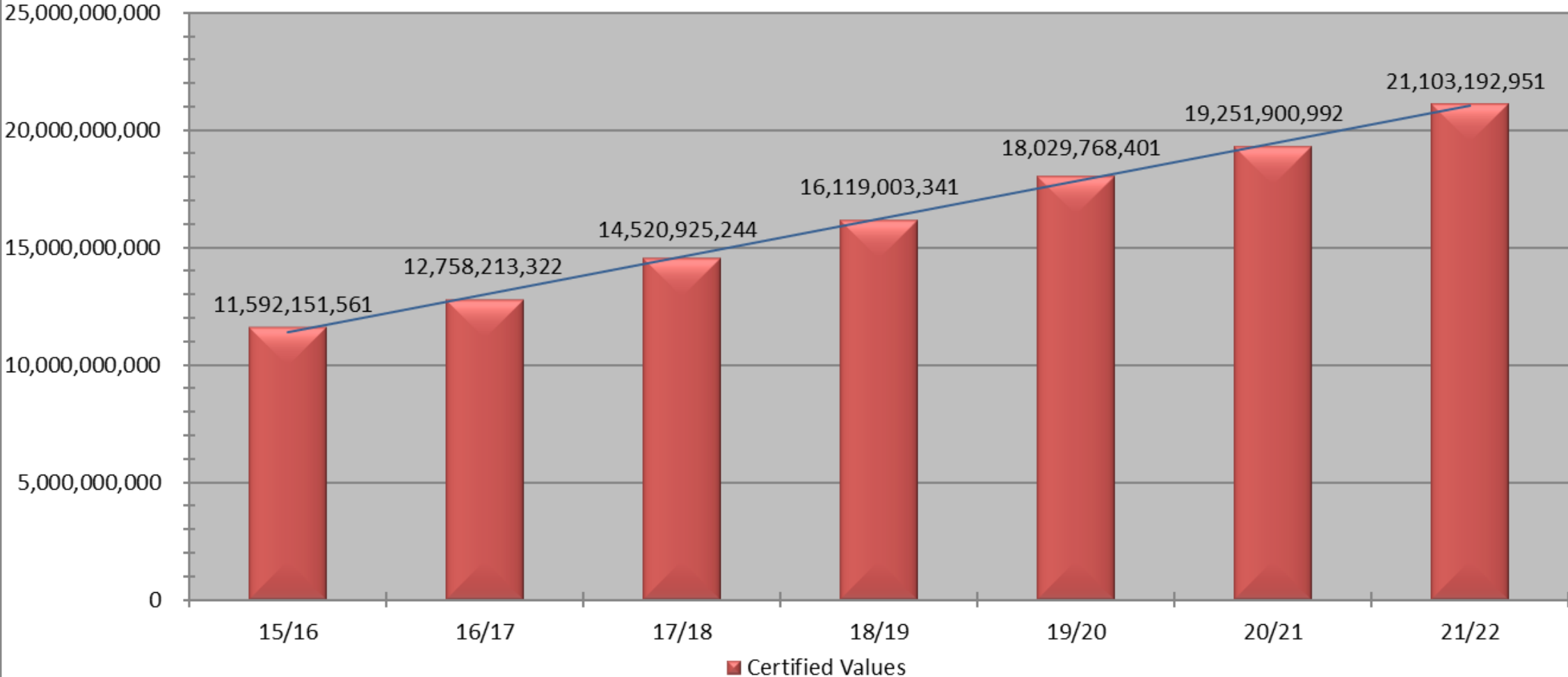
Timeline of Tax Rate Adoption



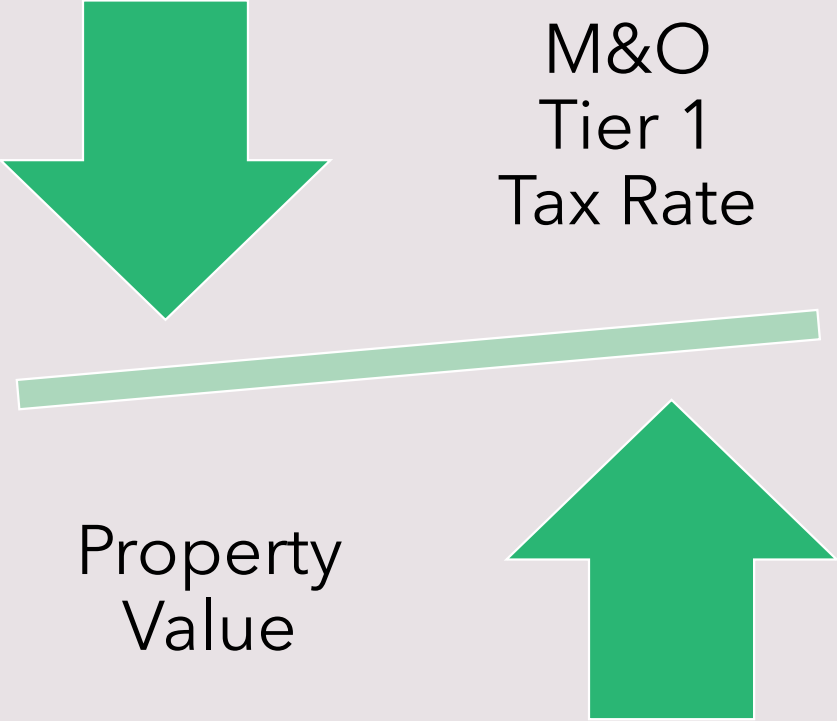

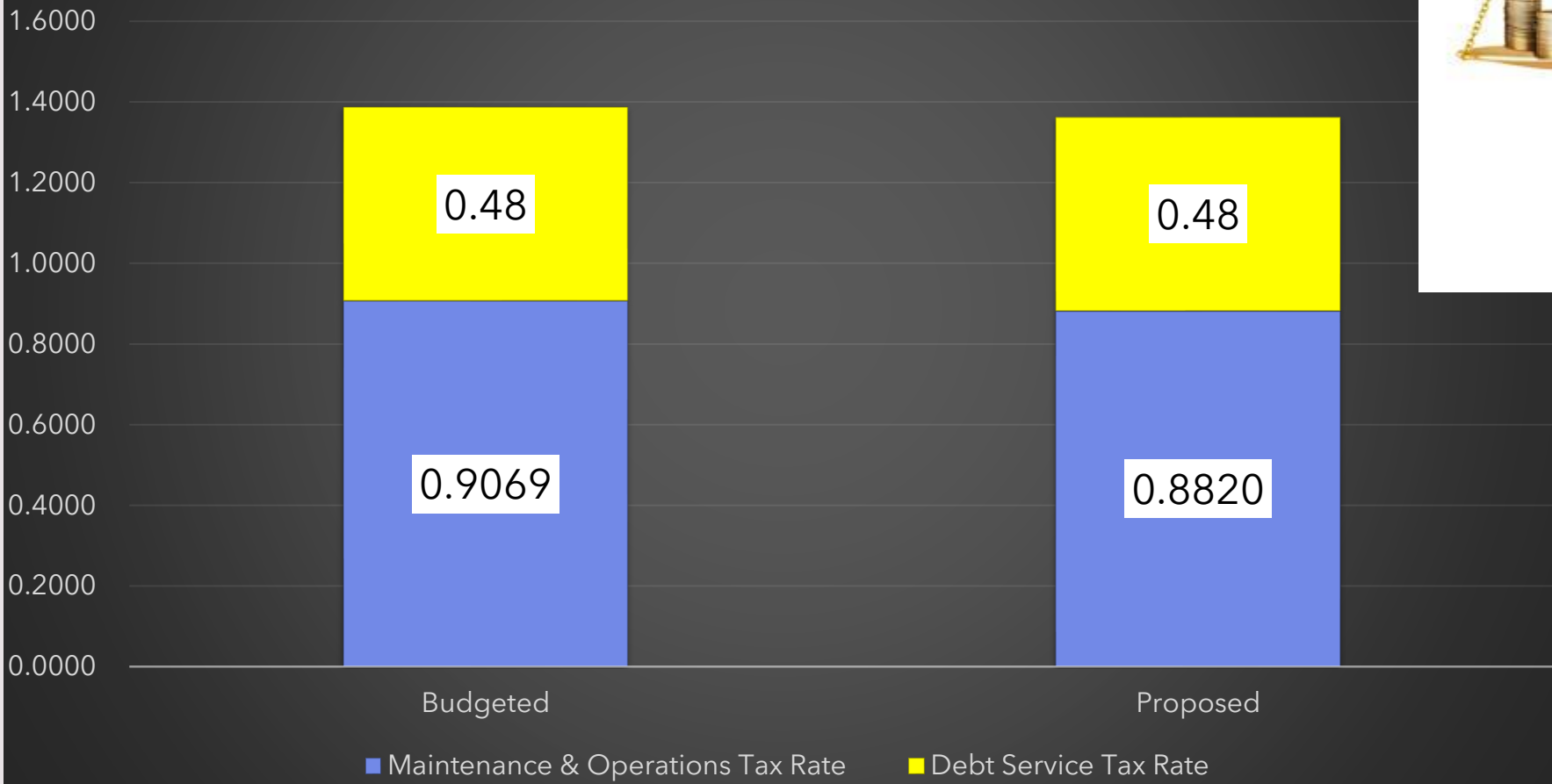
Denton Independent School District Comparison of Certified Property Values



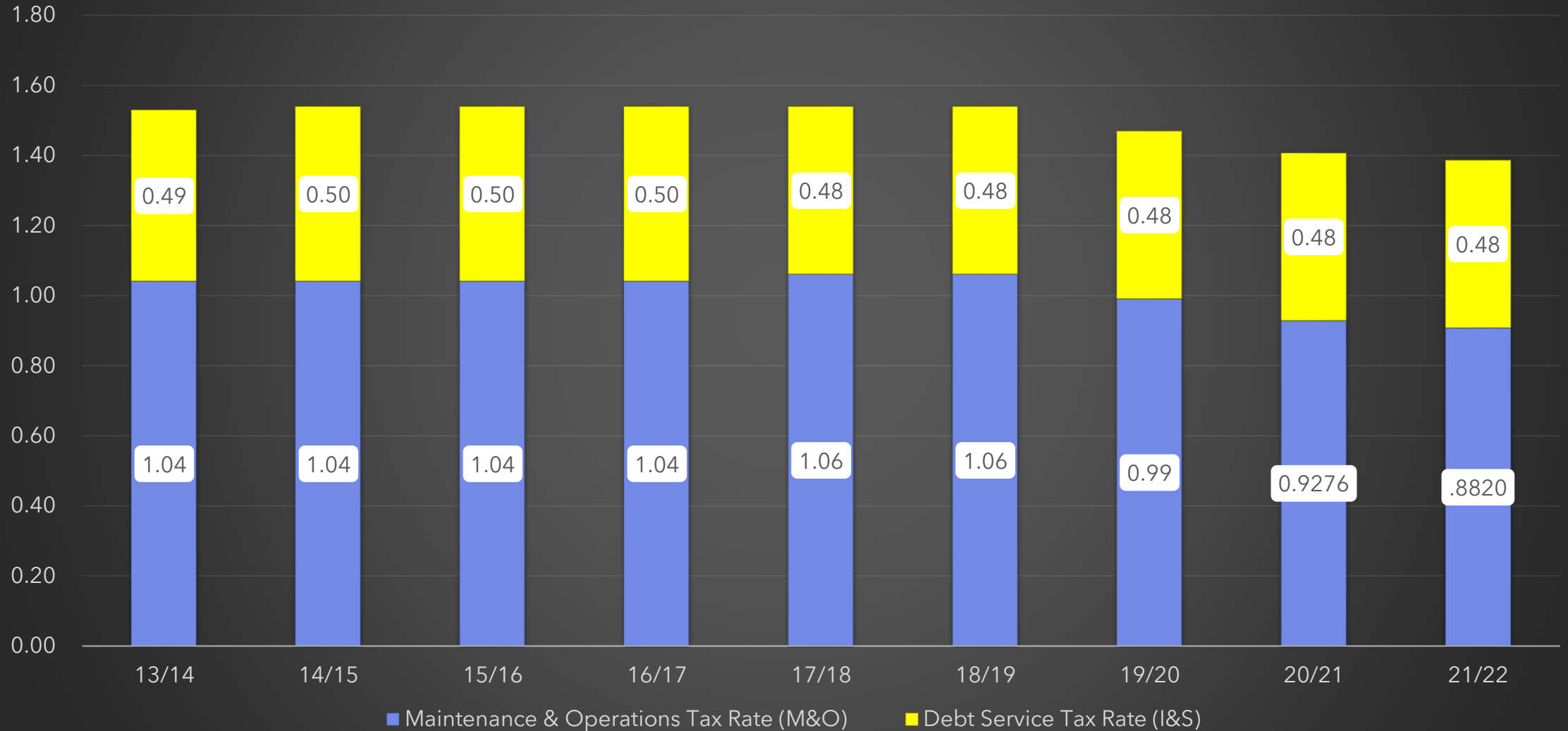
Tax Rate Compression



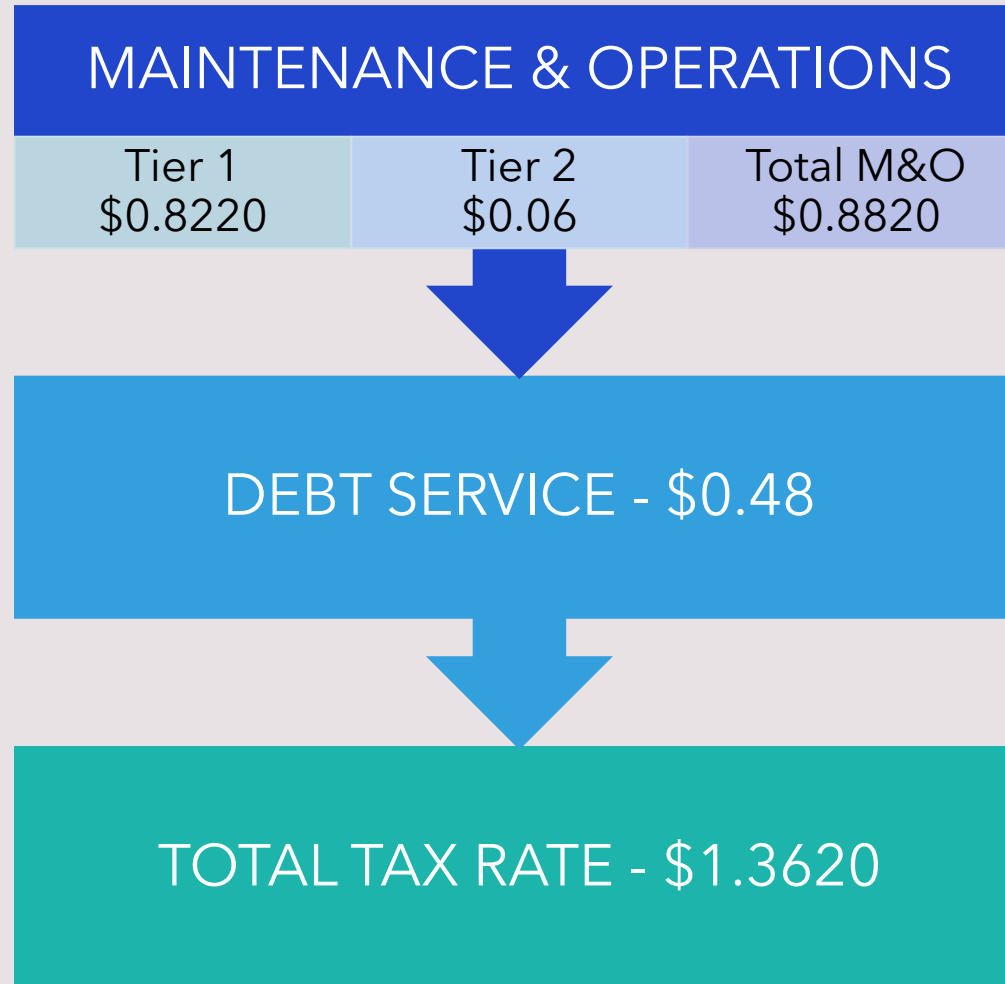
Denton Independent School District Comparison of Budgeted Tax Rate vs Proposed Tax Rate
