A component of the first phase of the Five Year Technology Capital Outlay Plan targets replacing antiquated desktop computers in various locations throughout the district. Inventory records, including computer age, warranty, and hardware specifications, as well as the expected use of the computers systems by staff and students, have been evaluated in determining which systems present an immediate need for replacement.

The older computers that are being replaced were originally purchased in 2000-2001. If beneficial, they will be redistributed to areas of the district that require less system functionality. However, in this instance these decade old computers most likely will be broken down and used for spare parts, or will be recycled in accordance with electronics recycling mandates.

These technology replacements are intended for Geneva High School's Science department. These computers are used with science probes, peripherals, and software that relates specifically with the high school science curriculum. These curricular related items have been tested to ensure continued functionality with newer model computers. The laptop computers that will be purchased will replace older laptops in one of the mobile carts currently used by multiple departments at GHS.
