Enrollment – Mrs. Schroeder and Mrs. Walther are monitoring enrollment closely. This was the projection on August 11, 2014:

First Grade	82	(have not heard from approved OE student)

Third Grade	58	(includes approved OE student)

Chromebooks/Keyboarding – Two sets of Chromebooks have been purchased for the elementary school. They will primarily be used by 3rd and 4th grade. Mrs. Hopkins will be teaching keyboarding to 3rd and 4th graders. Students will receive 8 weeks of keyboarding instruction.

New Teacher Orientation – New teachers will begin working on Tuesday, August 26. They will meet with Mr. Leschisin and district office staff, Mrs. Schroeder, Miss Nelsen and Ms. Brooks throughout the day.

Opening In-Service – All teachers will attend in-service on August 27th & 28th.
