PENDLETON SCHOOL DISTRICT School Board Goals 2015-16 School Year

To accomplish its mission of providing each student with a strong academic program in a safe, nurturing and supportive environment, each year the School Board establishes goals and priorities that provide a framework for the district's continuous improvement efforts. Goals for the 2015-16 school year are as follow:

Goal 1 - HIGH QUALITY TEACHING, LEARNING AND ENRICHMENT

Provide high quality instruction for all students in an aligned P-12 system resulting in increased student achievement and successful college and career readiness.

- 1. Further develop the PSD Educator Mentoring and Retention program, focusing on effectiveness and sustainability.
- 2. Refine, implement and monitor the PSD Instructional Guidelines.
- 3. Develop and implement a sustainable Extended Learning Program (to include summer school and before/after school programs).
- 4. Continue the district's focus on cultural competency.
- 5. Improve student attendance by increasing the number of students not chronically absent by 10%.
- 6. Increase participation on SAT and/or ACT by at least 10% for all student groups.
- 7. Increase participation in AP/dual credit/Eastern Promise courses by at least 5% for all student groups.
- 8. Continue efforts to expand elective programs in grades 6-12.

Goal 2 - SAFE, HEALTHY AND NURTURING ENVIRONMENT

Provide an educational environment where students are safe, supported and empowered in their learning.

- 1. Focus efforts to improve student behavior through the Positive Behavior Supports System.
- 2. Foster a positive school climate throughout the district.
- 3. Provide ongoing anti-bullying training for staff and students.
- 4. Develop and implement staff and student emergency response drill and practice program.
- 5. Train all staff to successfully utilize the modernized security and technology system as designed.

Goal 3 - OUTREACH, INVOLVEMENT AND PARTNERSHIPS

Leverage our skills and resources with parents and community partners to strengthen P-12 educational programs.

- 1. Develop the PSD Career Technical Education Program through a focus on student/community needs and expanded business/industrial partnerships.
- 2. Continue efforts to increase parental involvement and expand parent education opportunities.
- 3. Continue to build and nurture a positive relationship with the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation.
- 4. Develop early learning partnerships locally and at the state level in order to establish a seamless P-12 system.
