SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of agreement between Denton ISD and the City of Denton for the summer feeding program.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The District and the City of Denton have developed a partnership to provide lunches for students participating in programs sponsored by the Parks and Recreation Department. The District has supported this program for many years.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This program provides sack lunches prepared by the Child Nutrition Department for students who qualify for the free and reduced-price meals program. These students are involved in activities sponsored by the Parks and Recreation Department and summer school programs.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Approval of this agreement will allow planning to proceed for the City of Denton and the District.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The City of Denton is responsible for all costs related to the program.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The program will provide lunches to children during the summer months when school is not in session.

PROCEDURAL AND REPORTING IMPLICATIONS:

The City of Denton reimburses Child Nutrition for sack lunches at \$2.00 per lunch to pay for the costs of food, supplies, and labor. Sack lunches are to be prepared in the Denton High School kitchen.
