Comparing Eureka and Bluebonnet Math

- 15% change from Eureka
- Now 165 lessons per year compared to 180
- No longer going beyond the TEKS
- 100% aligned to ELPS/TEKS
- Common misconceptions added
- Important terminology with definitions and images added
- Supplemental Lessons are included in the 165 lessons
- Assessments are STAAR formatted, no multi-part items
- Videos for content grade bands
- Roadmaps (when TEKS are started, revisited, and mastered)

Major Content Changes:

- 3rd Grade Fractions Unit
- 4th and 5th Grade Multi-Digit Multiplication Unit
- 5th Grade Order of Operations Unit

An Inventory Adjustment will be submitted to TEA for their removal from the district's (Educational Materials (EMAT) inventory.

NEW MATERIALS

Spanish materials adoption expires EOY 2025. State Board of Education (SBOE) review set for 2027 and the new approved list should be available in 2028.

The Multi-Lingual Coordinator and Spanish teachers reviewed new materials and recommend a six-year purchase of Vista Higher Learning's [Senderos](#).
