### Summer School

Summer School had many opportunities for our students this year with 255.5 hours of summer learning offered for our 4K-8 students.

One new exciting class that students enjoyed was Campfire Cooking. Students learned how to cook over an open flame just like in camping. One of the tasks was to start their own fires from just one match. Students set up and took down camp each day while still getting to enjoy yummy camping food and games.

Our Passport to Literacy program had 95 students participating with an average of 876.25 minutes of students reading per week. As of right now, our students have read over 15,100 pages with many, many more students to hand in their logged pages in their passports.

### New Curriculum training has begun

Teachers have been on-site participating in training and collaborative opportunities with both our new English Language Arts and Math curriculum. Teams of teachers are excited to implement these new programs for our students.

### Science/ Social Studies Approach in Grades 4/5

Science and Engineering are the future of our students' world. Students in 4th and 5th grade will get to experience Science in a whole new way. We have adopted the Amplify Science curriculum in which our students will get to engage in hands-on learning opportunities involving Science every day. Our students will get to use their creativity and wonder to discover more about the world around them and how it works.

Social Studies will also have a new approach this year. Focusing on the Wisconsin State Standards, our 4th and 5th grade students will dive deep into the inquiry based model. They will ask questions, research and create projects that will showcase their discovery about the world and history around them. Our Social Studies curriculum is InquirED for 5th grade and the Wisconsin Historical Society Curriculum for 4th grade.
