### CDL/Elk Hunting

This course will consist of two main parts: Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Training and the University of Elk Hunting course through Elk101.

<u>CDL Training</u>: This portion of the course is designed to teach students the knowledge necessary to obtain their Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL) in the state of Idaho and will cover the basic course requirements to pass the written portion of the ELDT (Entry Level Driver Training) training course and the walk-through portion of the test.

<u>Elk Hunting 101</u>: This portion of the course will follow the University of Elk Hunting online course that has been developed by Corey Jacobsen through Elk101. Participation in this course will provide students with a complete knowledge in all aspects of becoming a confident and successful elk hunter.
