Background Information

A verbal administrative update will be presented at the board meeting.

Digital Equity Survey	The State will be requiring school districts to administer a survey requesting information about each student’s Internet access and available computer devices. A plan is being developed to collect the information.
Payments to Health Partners for Well at Work Clinic	A board member asked how much the district pays annually to Health Partners for the Well at Work Clinic. Jackie responded that costs are found in fund 22 each year. Last year, the district spent \$372,330. This year, the expenditure budget is \$392,397. The school district pays about 75% of the costs and the city pays about 25% of the costs depending on the number of visits for each group.
CDC Guidelines	The latest version of CDC guidelines for school this fall is included as an “extra.” The Minnesota Department of Education and Minnesota Department of Health will issue guidance after reviewing CDC’s recommendations.
Legislative Summary	MSBA’s legislative summary is included as an “extra.”
Attendance Zones and Transportation Information	Our transportation router recently provided the first draft of attendance zones for elementary schools. After adjustments are made, parents will be notified of their school assignments.
