## **Potential Budget and Program Changes**

Identified Goals for the Meeting:

Superintendent Lutz presented the Budget Reduction Recommendations totaling \$4,163,000.00 which included reductions in the following areas: BHS one year "patch"; enrollment driven section adjustments; attrition in FY 21 SY; move early childhood programs to elementary buildings; closing Community Education building; vacating Midway property; closing Central Elementary; participation in Students First Programming; restructuring Oshki program; hiring delay for audio technician; absorb existing staff into Title IV positions; reduction in supply, equipment, and classroom budgets; elimination of Accelerated Reader program; and Staff Development one-time transfer.

Additional Considerations for Future Discussion:

Superintendent Lutz presented Other Considerations for Budget Reductions totaling \$1,615,000.00 which included the following reductions: restructure of BHS schedule; re-allocation of grade levels; elimination of JROTC program at BHS; Career Academy support staff; Transportation support staff; Custodial staff; Special Education para positions; Bemidji Middle School extracurricular programs; Media Specialist position; fifth grade orchestra; tech device replacement delay; reduction of number of extracurricular contests; reduction of School Board salaries; and include a contract pay freeze for FY 2021-2022.

Next Steps for February School Board Meeting:

Superintendent Lutz will provide School Board Members with a document that will allow them to score and rate their budget reduction priorities. The results of this survey will be shared at the next School Board Meeting.

A discussion regarding moving Early Childhood classes from Paul Bunyan to area elementary schools and the process for closing elementary schools will be discussed at the next meeting.
