

Curriculum Adoption Committee Acknowledgment

<u>Purpose</u>

This committee reviews curriculum materials for courses offered by the district. The composition of the committee and its function are described in Idaho Code 33-512A and District Policies 2520, and 2540. The aim of the Curriculum Adoption Committee shall be to recommend the most reasonable curricular resources that are best suited for student learning. The Board of Trustees is responsible for approving curriculum. Curriculum reviewed by the state curricular materials adoption committee is encouraged for selection, but it is not required for the District to approve and purchase.

Responsibilities

At any given time, the Curriculum Adoption Committee may:

- Advise the Board on the selection of curricular materials for use within the District.
- Meet to research curricular materials for District offered educational programs.
- Gather input from community members residing in the District who are not members of the committee.

Composition

- Trustees (2)
- Public Educators
- A minimum of one half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the committee members must be:
 - Parents of children attending school in the District; and/or
 - o Students attending school in the District; and/or
 - o Community members residing within the District; and
 - Must not be a Public Educator or Trustee of the District.
