Design and Process

After a successful referendum, it is the responsibility of the Permanent Building Committee to develop plans and specifications for school facilities based on the information they receive from the Board of Education contained in the Educational Specifications. A designated Board of Education representative shall attend all meetings of the Permanent Building Committee, and provide liaison services between Town Committees and the Superintendent of Schools. Plans and specifications, after being approved by the Permanent Building Committee shall be presented to the Board of Education for approval. ~~After a successful referendum, t~~ The project will be constructed under the direction of the Town of New Fairfield Permanent Building Committee.
