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Minutes of the June 26, 2023 - Regular School Board Meeting

The Board of Trustees of the Coppell Independent School District, #057-922, met in a regular session on June 26, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. at the Vonita White Administration Building, 200 S. Denton Tap Road, Coppell, Texas. The meeting was called to order by President David Caviness at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Greg Gibson, Gibson Consulting Group, presented the program evaluation results to the Board of Trustees. Dr. Brad Hunt, Superintendent, provided a STAAR Redesign and Accountability update.

CONSENT

Trustee Leigh Walker motioned to pull item 5, approve College Transition as an innovative course for the 2023-2024 school year, from the consent agenda for further discussion.

Nichole Bentley made a motion to approve the following consent agenda items with the exception of item #5:

Anthony Hill seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

<u>ACTION</u>

Leigh Walker motioned to approve College Transition as an Innovative Course for 2023-2024 School Year. Nichole Bentley seconded the motion and the motion passed 5-0.

A motion was made by Manish Sethi to approve all matters incident and related to the issuance and sale of "Coppell Independent School District Unlimited Tax School Building Bonds, Series 2023", including the adoption of an order authorizing the issuance of such bonds, establishing parameters for the sale and issuance of such bonds and delegating certain matters to authorized District officials. Anthony Hill seconded the motion and the motion passed 5-0.

A motion was made by Anthony Hill and seconded by Leigh Walker to approve the recommended compensation increases as presented. (This is 4% raise of control point for 187-day employees including teachers and nurses who will receive a \$ 2,550 cost of living increase. Librarians on a 197-day contract will receive a pro-rated increase. The beginning teacher pay for 187 contracts will be \$61,150 for 2023-2024. All other employees will receive a 4% cost-of-living increase on midpoint. The motion carried 5-0.

Nichole Bentley nominated Jobby Mathew to serve as an official voting delegate to the 2023-2024 TASB Delegate Assembly and Ranna Raval to serve as the alternate delegate to the 2023-2024 TASB Delegate Assembly. Manish Sethi seconded the nominations. The Board voted 5-0 in favor of the nominations.

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The board discussed and decided to take no action to nominate a candidate for the Region 10, Position D, seat on the TASB Board.

Manish Sethi motioned to adopt all changes/modifications to the Board Operating Procedures as discussed and presented. Anthony Hill seconded the motion and the motion passed 5-0.
