



Secondary School Board Report

December, 2024

1. E-Learning Day
 - a. The district had its first e-learning session on Monday, December 9th due to icy conditions.
 - b. Starting this year we have asked our paraprofessionals to reach out to students with IEP's during e-learning days and see if they need any support. Though we weren't all set up yet, the paraprofessionals took on the task and it went well overall. Mrs. Demuth and I will discuss changes to the process for future e-learning days but overall I am happy with the outcome.
2. Master Schedule
 - a. I have been working with several departments over the past several weeks to begin to explore alternative ways for students to earn credits for graduation in each of their departments. So far I have met with Phy Ed/Health, English, and Math departments.
 - b. Teachers have been asked to continue to brainstorm after our meetings and discuss their ideas at their next PLC. I will then follow up with each of the departments and discuss the possibilities for the 2025-2026 school year.
3. Attendance
 - a. For the past three years, after 65 days of school, the average percent attendance is 92.49%. This is down from 2018 (Pre Covid) when the average percent attendance was 95.33%. Our overall attendance percentage for the 4 years is 93.20%. For comparison, the state average is around 90.6%.
