**Subject**: Green Centerpiece Master Strategy Update

## **Background Information:**

 The operating partners for the Green Centerpiece Master Strategy and Lewisville Lake Environmental Learning Area (LLELA) are the City of Lewisville, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, University of North Texas (UNT) and LISD.

- The central area of the Green Centerpiece is land owned by the Department of the Army-U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The property is located immediately south of Lake Lewisville and north of Business Hwy 121. There are approximately 2,700 acres of this land leased to the City of Lewisville, UNT and the District.
- The shared goals and purpose of this land lease include fish & wildlife management, environmental research, environmental education and habitat restoration.
- The Operating Partners were convened by the City of Lewisville to work on updates to the Green Centerpiece Master Strategy from the original items presented in 2018.
- This Green Centerpiece Master Strategy is part of the City of Lewisville's "Lewisville 2025" program.
- LISD currently operates the Lewisville ISD Outdoor Learning Area (LISDOLA) adjacent to LLELA and included in the Green Centerpiece land space.

## **Administrative Consideration:**

- LISD Board of Trustees and Operating Partners adopted the Green Centerpiece Master Strategy in June 2022.
- The City of Lewisville led the Operating Partners and various stakeholders to convene in the summer of 2025 to assess progress made since 2022, discuss and update action items to better position the partnership to achieve its ultimate vision for the Green Centerpiece.
