

In determining whether and to whom to award a contract, the District will base its selection on a point system to evaluate the proposals and will consider the following criteria:

<u>CRITERIA</u>	<u>AVAILABLE POINTS</u>
1. price;	0 – 20 points
2. reputation of contractor and contractor's goods or services;	0 – 30 points
3. quality of contractor's goods or services;	0 – 20 points
4. extent to which the goods or services meet the district's needs;	0 – 10 points
5. the contractor's past relationship with the district;	0 – 10 points
6. the impact on the ability of the district to comply with laws and rules relating to historically underutilized businesses;	0 – 5 points
7. the total long-term cost to the district to acquire the contractor's goods or services;	0 – 5 points
8. Contractor's experience in the specific area of construction necessary for the Project;	0 – 25 points
9. Record of past performance on comparable jobs;	0 – 20 points
