MCA testing began the week of April 17th. Grades 3-6 completed math and reading. Grade 5 also did a science test. MCA testing officially ended during the first week for the elementary school. The scores at this time are not final. Firm scores will be available in July according to MDE.

The elementary students will do a final STAR assessment the week of May 22nd to complete the year. This will be the fourth STAR assessment this school year for the students. If you recall, the STAR replaced the NWEA's as our benchmarking and progress monitoring tool. We look forward to the results and comparisons.
