INSTRUCTION

6:330 Student Recognition

As a school district, the Board of Education promotes the recognition of student achievement and excellence. At regular meetings or special meetings of the Board of Education, the Superintendent or designee, may submit to the Board the names of those students who have received honors or awards relating to school, whether awarded internally or by agencies outside the school.

In addition to the above, students may be singled out for personal appearance at a Board meeting who have brought significant honor to themselves, their school, and the District by being selected for special honors or awards in competition with students on a National, State or other such prominent level. At that meeting, a letter of recognition and commendation or a Tradition of Excellence award will be presented to the student. When appropriate, the student may also be given opportunity to briefly describe the nature of his/her involvement in the activity for which he/she is being honored.
