

Designation of Integrated Pest Management Coordinator

SUMMARY:

The Board will consider designating Bill Knight as the DISD Coordinator for Integrated Pest Management.

BOARD GOALS:

1. Promote and nourish a safe learning and working environment which is supportive, cooperative, ethical, and ensures open communication. 2. Work continuously with the community in planning and facility development. Also, provide support services and promote health and wellness for students and families. 3. Develop and expect a consistently high level of, and respect for, professional performance by all staff. 4. Be environmentally responsible and aggressively pursue energy efficiency and conservation principles in building design, transportation alternatives, and operating procedures.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

Paul Andress was previously approved as the DISD coordinator for Integrated Pest Management on November 11, 1997.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The law requires that the Board of Trustees designate a district employee as the Coordinator for Pest Management Services.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The District Integrated Pest Management Coordinator is required to attend training and certification sessions.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The only monetary provisions will be to pay for the required training.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The District will meet the requirement of the law.


