Dear Mr. Skolnik:


On April 6, 2026, you submitted a Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") request to Riverside School District 96 (the "District"). Your request and the District's response are below:

**Request:** I request that I be given a copy of any and all anonymous letters sent to any and all members of the Riverside Elementary School District 96 Board of Education between the dates of January 1, 2025, and June 25, 2025, that mentioned Angela Dolezal.

**Response:** See Attached. As an added comment, please note that this anonymous letter was not the reason for Angela Dolezal's resignation.

To the extent you interpret this as a denial of your request, you have the right to have denials reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to: Public Access Counselor, Office of the Attorney General, 500 South 2nd Street Springfield, Illinois 62701, Fax: 217-782-1396, E-mail: [public.access@ilag.gov](mailto:public.access@ilag.gov), Phone: 877-299-3642. If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days after the date of the denial letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original request for documents and the denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC. You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the State circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11.
