SUBJECT: RENEWAL OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF FORT WORTH

BOARD GOAL: All students will achieve educational excellence

FISCAL NOTE: Fort Worth Crime Prevention Control

Background Information:

- The City of Fort Worth and Keller ISD - collaboration during 2000-2006 to provide needs-based after-school programs
- Purpose of each program - provide safe, secure environments after school hours during a time when children might be going home alone
- Activities – homework, etc.
- Financed through funds allocated for Crime Prevention

Administrative Considerations:

- The City of Fort Worth and Keller Independent School District want to continue this collaboration.
- Contract term will cover the 2006-2007 school year with an annual funding amount of \$125,000.
- The After School Program is offered in five schools: Parkview Elementary, Heritage Elementary, North Riverside Elementary, Parkwood Hill Intermediate and Chisholm Trail Intermediate.
- Site selection is based on the campus being located in the Fort Worth Crime Prevention and Control District.
- Clayton Child Care, a non-profit organization, will be the provider of these services.
- The program will focus on activities which enhance the areas of fine arts and academic enrichment, especially reading for pleasure.
