

• The current 4 year fleet plan began in preparation for the 2022-2023 School year and runs through the completion of the 2025-2026 School Year.

#### Recap:

- Goals included; increasing efficiencies for regular ed transportation, increasing the ability to bus more outplacement Sp. Ed students, lower fleet size if possible, cut overall equipment costs in the short term and a stable cost control over the 4 year cycle.
  - Regular Ed routes were reduced from 10 to 7 while still offering bus service to all D66 students.
  - To combat rising new bus lease costs, we began purchasing our minibuses off of lease trade in as well as purchasing a full size spare bus as opposed to leasing.
  - Our Lease commitments V. owned equipment assets went from 14 total leases for the 21-22 school year down to 10 total leases as of the 24-25 school year and fleet size from 14 down to 13 total.

## **Transportation Purchasing Cycle**

In July of 2025 - D66 has 3 full sized buses scheduled to come off of current 5 year leases; #1,#8,#11. In preparation for the 2025-2026 School Year, I recommend to:

- Trade Bus #1, #8, #11 LEASE THREE (3) NEW 2026 Blue Bird T3FE 84
   Passenger Buses \$27,993.10/Bus/year 5 year lease.
- Retain the option to Purchase (6th Lease/Balloon Payment) the Bus #1 lease return should the District add another bus route - \$27,747.64

Total FY25 Fleet Cost est= **\$222,796.00** Total FY24 Fleet Cost = **\$204,167.00**

\$18,629.00 increase from 24-25

Presentation from last year estimated the new lease cost to be \$26,176/bus and the price came in higher at \$27,748/bus - reflecting a \$5,601 increase from the estimated flet cost presented last fall.

If an additional route is planned for 25-26, a decision can be made in May to purchase a Lease return bus
